### **Monitoring of Trends – Staff Injuries**

DR went through the presentation;

- 10 x UOF at BH in July all spontaneous (No planned used for removal)
- Brook House had an average roll count of 81.4 for the month of July.
- The percentage of Detainees that had force used on them was 8.14% of the population
- Minimal self-harm also had an impact
- The number of times force is used is climbing due to increased charter activity and frustration of Detainees
- There were 2 staff injuries in July

### **Training update**

- ITC UOF training place has been sanctioned by the Home Office and National C&R instructors using a “pod” method and PPE

- Refresher training has restarted as of 10/08/2020 with session every day
- Cellular Van training has taken place and more is booked in after refresher training.

**Use of Force Review completed during meeting**

**Date of incident**

**Comments;**

- Review Spontaneous UOF on ██████ who had been refused bail and then proceeded to damage centre property and become refractory

**Feedback**

- ██████ commented on the positioning of healthcare when the team got to the stairs. ██████ suggested that with 2 healthcare staff in attendance 1 should go in front of the team 1 behind. When going downstairs 1 should take up position on higher stairs so they get a better view of the detainee. ██████ also stated that the positioning of healthcare will depend on the situation.
- ██████ mentioned lack of instruction from Number 1, Also mentioned that 1 of the officers was out of ticket and that this is the second time he has used force in July. ██████ asked ██████ about this all officers should know they are out of ticket and the dispensation that is in place. ██████ commented that ██████ took over the situation due to being an instructor.
- ██████ commented that it was a good restraint with good techniques being applied.
- ██████ commented that there were other incidents happening at the same time one of which resulted in an officer being assaulted. So, the speed he was taken off the wing did help calm the other incidents.
- ██████ commented that ██████ was being given a barrage of abuse and may have moved away from the area. (This was not possible at the time)

**Outcome**

- Full Relocated to CSU Rule 40
- Handcuffs used
- Successful relocation, no injuries to the detainee

**Learning points**

- Healthcare to be aware of positioning when they are at an incident where force is being used.
- ██████ to be spoken with about the officer out of ticket.
- Number 1's to be encouraged to be more engaging when restraining someone
- Officers to mindful of making the situation worse and leaving the immediate area if the situation deems it safe to.
